Q.1] What was India called in the past?

Ans.1] In the past, India was called ‘The Golden Bird.’

Q.2] Who built the Taj Mahal? Why?

Ans.2] The Taj Mahal was built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan to house the tomb of his beloved wife, Mumtaz Mahal.

Q.3] Name the three emperors who built the Qutub Minar.

Ans.3] The three emperors who built the Qutub Minar were – Qutub-ud-Din-Aibak, Iltumish and Firoz Shah Tuglaq.

Q.4] What is national significance of the Red Fort?
