ANS-1 The Thar Desert is located in the North-western part of India, mostly in the state of Rajasthan. A part of it lies in Punjab and Sindh province of Pakistan. It also extends into the northern part of Gujarat and the southern part of Haryana.

ANS-2 Due to scanty rainfall in the desert region, the vegetation mostly consists of herbs, small plants and thorny bushes. Some hardy trees which can bear the dry conditions can be seen at a few places. Example keekar, babool, khejri etc.

Animals which can survive harsh weather conditions are found in this region. Example blackbucks, chital deer, camel, quail etc.

ANS-3 Rajasthan is one of the most popular tourist destinations in India, for both domestic and international tourists. Rajasthan attracts tourists for its historical forts, palaces, art and culture. Example Lake Palace in Udaipur, Amer palace in Jaipur, Bharatpur National Park etc. The cities are well connected with all parts of India.
