QD . ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:-

Ans1. The Central Highlands lie above the River Narmada.

It consists of the Malwa Plateau , Bundelkhand Plateau and ChotaNagpur Plateau.

This region is very rich in minerals like –coal, iron, manganese and mica.

Ans2. The Deccan Plateaus were created due to volcanic eruptions .

The Deccan Plateau is surrounded by the Western Ghats on the west, the Eastern Ghats on the east and the Nilgiri Hills on the south.

Most of the land in the Deccan Plateau slopes from West to East so majority of the rivers flow from west to east and ends in the Bay of Bengal.

The volcanic black soil and Red soil is found in this region.

Ans3. Madhya Pradesh is located in central India and Bhopal is the capital of Madhya Pradesh.

Tapi, Chambal , Narmada , Betwa and Son are the main rivers.

The main crops grown here are wheat, cotton , rice , jowar , maize , peas , beans , lentils ,

peanuts and linseed.

Chemical, rubber , leather , forest-based industries pharmaceuticals etc are major industries.

Ans4. Men wear dhotis and bright, colourful tribal dresses with attractive headgears and women wear bright coloured saris and lot of jewellery.

Agriculture, livestock farming , mining of iron ore , copper, mica , bauxite , graphite , limestone and uranium are main occupation of the people.

Some of the tribes present in Jharkhand are Santhal, Munda , Ho and Oraon.

Ans5. The Southern Plateau consists of the volcanic soil which is good for cultivation of cotton, millets, oilseeds, tea and coffee. Red soil is also found in this region.

The forest in this region have a wide variety of flora and fauna. Nilgai, blackbuck, leopard, boar, sambhar , elephant and spotted deer are the main animals found in this region.

Ans6. Telangana is one of the 29 th states in India and it was formed on June 2014.

Location:- It is located in Southern India.

Major cities:- Hyderabad, Warangal, Khammam, Karimnagar , Nizamabad.

Major rivers:- Godavari and Krishna

Climate:- Semi-arid area and has hot and dry climate. The annual rainfall is between 900 and 1500 mm.

Manufacturing and service industries:- Automobile and auto components industry, spices, mining minerals , textiles, pharmaceuticals, horticulture etc.

Important monuments:- Charminar, Golconda Fort, Qutb Shahi Tombs, Falaknuma Palace, Nagarjun Sagar etc.
