Ans1. We came to know about the life of the early man by studying the sources like fossils, cave paintings and artefacts like pottery, tools, weapons, utensils etc.

Ans2. In the Middle Stone Age, main occupation of the people remained hunting and gathering. Apart from rough stone tools ,they made small, sharp and pointed

tools. They started living in groups near sources of water and started cultivation of crops and domesticating animals.

Ans3. The early man used to live on trees and later on in caves.

Ans4. In their cave paintings , the early men depicted hunting scenes and large wild animals, pictures of humans usually represented as stick figures , outlines of their hands and abstract imagery.
