We were:

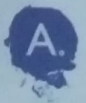
We were glad.

They were glad.

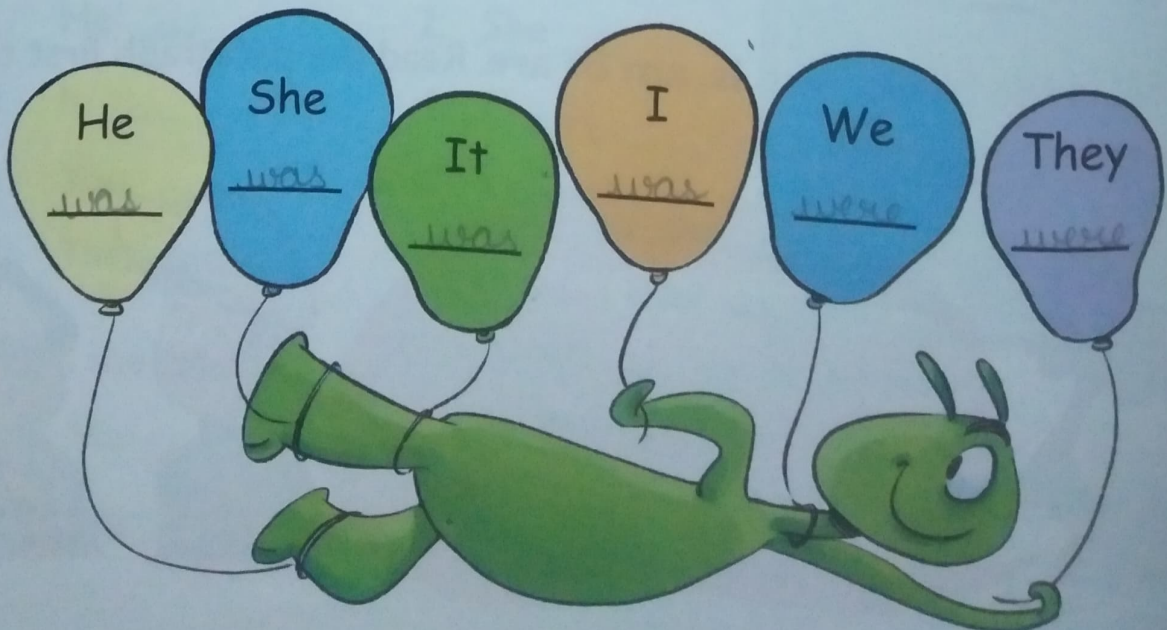
We use **were** for more than one person, animal or thing.

**Was** and **were** are used to show past time -

yesterday / last week / last month / last year, etc.
