- 1- A map is a diagrammatic representation of the surface of the Earth, as a whole or a part of it.

It is different from a globe as it is easy to carry along as they can be easily folded or rolled.

- 2- The four uses of a map are-

- i- It helps us to locate places like towns, cities etc.
ii- It also tells us about major routes of transportation like airways, railways and roadways.
iii- It is easy to carry as it can be easily rolled.

- iv- It also tells about a place like the physical features of earth, forests, crops and minerals.
- 3- The different types of maps are-
 - i- Political maps
 - ii- Physical maps and
 - iii- Subject-specific maps or Thematic maps.
- 4- A scale helps us to understand how far the destination actually is.
Scales are of two types-
 - i- Verbal scale
 - ii- Graphic or bar scale
